## MINUTES FAIRVIEW, TEXAS PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION THURSDAY, APRIL 13, 2023

The Planning and Zoning Commission met in regular session on Thursday, April 13, 2023, at 7:00 p.m. at 372 Town Place, Fairview, Texas. <u>DISCUSSION – FAIRVIEW TOWNHOME ADDITION</u>: Consider and discuss a request for approval of a Preliminary Plat of the Fairview Townhomes Addition. The 15.2-acre sites are generally located on both sides of Fairview Parkway, north of the Fairview Village Road/Latham Drive intersection and is zoned for the (CPDD) Commercial Planned Development District with the Urban Village Sub-district. Applicant: Mike Molge, Kimley-Horn & Associates, representing HHS Residential, LLC and owners Travis Parker Associates, LTD.

Mr. Roberts reviewed the staff report on this item. He indicated this plat was previously presented and approved by the commission. He reviewed the steps to date and stated the previous plat expired on January 3, 2023 which required the approval process to restart; and there have been no changes to the layout or lots since the previous approval.
