7. Discuss internet service providers and broadband technology and services within the Town of Fairview and take any necessary action.


The committee discussed the fiber currently being installed throughout town by AT&T.

8. Receive reports from staff or the Technology Advisory Committee about items of community interest.


Chairman Adler mentioned that the pancake breakfast put on by the Friends of Fairview Firefighters Association at fire station #2 would be taking place on October 1st.
