The meeting will be accessible through in person or virtual attendance. A meeting can be held with a member participating by videoconference provided that there is a quorum of members physically present at the location that is open to the public. One or more council members may attend the meeting via video conference.

CLOSED SESSION (EXCEPTIONS) Under Tex. Gov't Code Chapter 551, the Town Council may enter closed session to discuss any items listed or referenced on a posted agenda notice for this meeting as necessary under the following exceptions to the Open Meetings Act under Texas Government Code:

Section 551.071 – to consult with legal counsel regarding pending or contemplated litigation and/or on matters in which the duty of the attorney to the governmental body under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas clearly conflicts with Chapter 551 of the Government Code including CPDD development improvements, ordinances, agreements and financing; contracts for services; town property and infrastructure; drainage matters; town ordinances, state law review and compliance.

Section 551.072 - discuss or deliberate the purchase, exchange, sale, lease, or value of real property; acquisition of right-of-way, easements, or land.

The council further reserves the right to enter into executive session at any time throughout any duly noticed meeting under any applicable exception to the Open Meetings Act.
