

## Important Fence Information

- (1) It shall be unlawful to install or construct any fence or wall, or to repair or replace more than 40% of any existing fence or wall in a single calendar year, without first obtaining a permit from the chief building official of the town or his or her designee. If more than 40% but less than 60% of a fence or wall should be repaired or replaced in a single calendar year, the fence must be replaced with like materials. If 60% or more of a fence or wall should be replaced in a single calendar year, the entire fence or wall must be replaced.
- (2) The required fee shall be paid prior to the issuance of a permit, said fee amount to be contained on the town's master fee schedule.
- (3) The chief building official may refuse to issue a fence or wall permit to any person previously convicted or cited for violation of any provision of this section.
- (4) A plot plan shall be submitted with a permit application showing the lot dimensions, structures, improvements, and location of the proposed fence or wall.
- (5) Upon completion of a fence or wall, structures must be inspected and approved by the chief building official or his or her designee.
