

# *Town of Fairview*

## *May 4, 2019 General Election Information*

The 2019 Town of Fairview General Election will be held on May 4, 2019. Seats with terms expiring in 2019 include the Mayor and Councilmember Seats 1, 3 and 5.

### *Candidate Packets:*

- Candidate packets will be available for pickup at Town Hall beginning **January 2, 2019** or you may email the City Secretary at [tbethel@fairviewtexas.org](mailto:tbethel@fairviewtexas.org) to receive a candidate packet electronically. Completed original applications must be filed with the Town Secretary and electronic packets will not be accepted.

### *Filing Period for Prospective Candidates in the May 4, 2019 Election:*

- Wednesday, January 16, 2019 - Friday, February 15, 2019 at 5:00 p.m. (All applications must be submitted to the City Secretary's office at Town Hall)

### *Drawing for Order Placement on the Ballot:*

- Should any Town Council seat have more than one candidate running, a drawing to determine the order in which the names of candidates are to be printed on the ballot will be held on Thursday, February 21, 2019 at 10:00 am in the Town Council Chambers.

### *Eligibility:*

To be eligible to apply for a place on the ballot a prospective candidate must meet the following criteria:

- Be no less than twenty-one (21) years of age
- Have resided in the Town no less than 12 (twelve) months immediately preceding election day
- Qualified voter of the Town
- Meet the requirements of the Texas Election Code
- Must continually reside within the Town limits during the term of office
- Has never been convicted of and is not currently charged with a felony or a crime involving moral turpitude

### *Acceptable Forms of ID for Voting in Person*

- Texas Driver's License issued by the Texas Department of Public Safety
- Texas Election Identification Certificate issued by Department of Public Safety
- Texas personal identification card issued by Department of Public Safety
- Texas license to carry a handgun issued by Department of Public Safety
- United States military identification card containing the person's photograph
- United States citizenship certificate containing the person's photograph
- United States Passport
