

According to the General prohibition of the Stormwater Quality Ordinance, No person shall introduce any discharge that is not entirely composed of stormwater into the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4). The following is a summarized list of substances that cannot be included in this discharge. For the full list of substances and regulations please view the Stormwater Quality section in the Towns ordinances. The following is a partial list:

- Motor oil
- Anti-freeze
- Industrial waste
- Hazardous waste
- Domestic sewage
- Wastewater from commercial floor or carpet cleaning
- Swimming pool water containing harmful amounts of chlorine (allowed if chlorine dissipates prior to release)
- Substances or materials that will damage, or block the MS4
- Solid or liquid substances causing obstruction to flow in storm sewers
- Harmful quantities of sediment, silt, earth or soil
- Any used oil should not be applied to land for dust suppression, weed abatement, or other similar uses
- No line conveying sanitary sewage, domestic or industrial, shall be connected to the MS4
